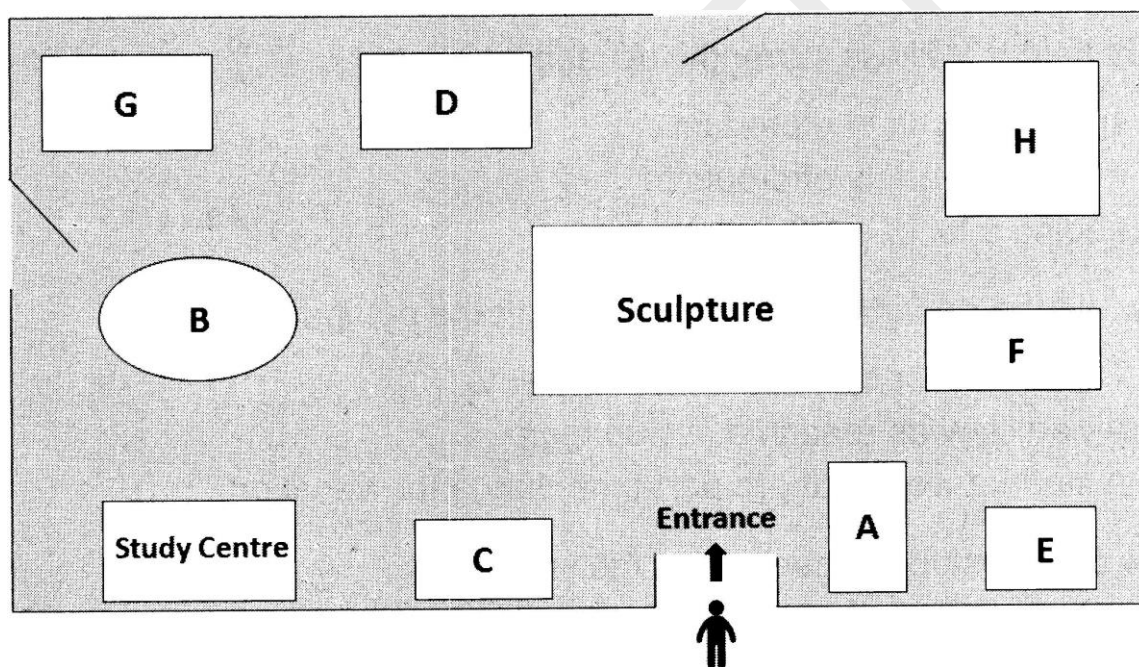

Listen carefully and answer questions 11 to 15.

Speaker 0: Good morning ladies and gentlemen. Silence, please. We are not ready to stop the meeting.

Speaker 0: I have called this meeting to discuss city museum matters as there have been a number of changes made and I want to ensure that you will all fully informed.

Speaker 0: There will be time for questions at the end so please don't interrupt until I'm finished.

Speaker 0: Now that the formalities are out of the way, let's begin.

Speaker 0: Firstly, some rumors have been brought to my attention that's our regular receptionist Jane has been fired for her inexperience but this is untrue, I want to set the record straight.

Speaker 0: **Jane has had to take sick leave because she is ill (11).** David is temporarily taking Jane's place at reception.

Speaker 0: He is also continuing his work as a security guard so please be considerate as he is quite busy.

Speaker 0: Second on the agenda is the master of the new Egyptian display at the museum.

Speaker 0: A very generous benefactor who wishes to remain anonymous has donated a large collection of Egyptian tombs and Mondays to improve our display.

Speaker 0: As we have a surplus of stuff, I see no need to hire extra employees to monitor this new display which means that you will have the exciting opportunity of taking on this responsibility. Any volunteers can put their names forward after the meeting.

Speaker 0: Thanks to a number of generous donations last year, the museum is certainly not suffering from a lack of money.

Speaker 0: **I do however, feel that we are short of publicity so I'm hiring a new public relations team which will hopefully be able to attract more new visitors to come and view our magnificent display. (12)**

Speaker 0: I now have a serious matter to address.

Speaker 0: As you all aware, a priceless statue was stolen from the museum last week during the annual open night.

Speaker 0: Police questioned everyone at the scene and they provided us with the reports on how the thieves were able to get past our security precautions.

Speaker 0: All of the items in our displays are listed in our brochure and on our website, which is a very valuable results for the public. **The security guards at this site are very well trained but the online information meant that the thieves were able to steal the statue, because they knew what they were looking for. (13)**

Speaker 0: We have also looked at our security system to see if it can be upgraded.

Speaker 0: However, we have been told that it will not be outdated for another five years.

Speaker 0: It has been suggested by the police that we hire more guards. However I do not believe this would be the right approach.

Speaker 0: We would run the danger of having too much security which would intimidate visitors and cause them to feel unsafe.

Speaker 0: **Instead I feel that we should buy some new closed-circuit television cameras so that we can monitor every part of gallery without disturbing all visitors. (14)**

Speaker 0: Another benefit to this system is that there is no need to buy anymore computers to display the camera feeds as we already have some spare our store.

Speaker 0: Now let's move on to other matters.

Speaker 0: We have expanded our supply of books at the library. And I'm therefore looking to hire a new member of staff. This job role does not carry many responsibilities but our new librarian should have worked in the library. **In other**

words they should be experienced (15) We welcome young applicants who are interested in becoming highly trained in the art of book preservation.
